

The Post-Calculus Test Instructions

Calculus Concepts Inventory

A post-Calc Test is given on Monday December 1st during lecture in class since the Math Department needs to know students' knowledge after taking calculus.

- Your exam will be graded, but this will have no effect on your final grade for the class. Taking the test will be a good review for the actual final exam. You should bring a number 2 pencil, if possible.
- This exam will be given instead of in-class quiz.
- Though your grade will have no effect on your final grade you can earn exactly **two** bonus quiz points when you:
 - 1) Sign in with the instructor after the exam.
 - 2) Fill in all the personal information correctly and completely (it will be one of those OP-SCAN forms). Instructions for this will be given by the instructor before the exam.
 - 3) Use the *bulk* (at least 30 minutes) of the 50 minutes for the test.
 - 4) Do your best on the test. It will be compared to the pre-test from the beginning of the semester.
